Presentation by Sabrina Iacovetta from the Thornton Fire Department

Kitchen Safety: (#1 cause of home fires)

- Stay in the kitchen while cooking. Have a spoon in your hand or set a timer so you don't forget what's on the stove.
- Keep the kitchen free of combustible food-oven mitts, towels, etc. that could catch on fire.
- Grease fires: DO NOT use water to put it out, simply cover with a lid which removes the oxygen. NO flour, baking powder or salt.
- Close the door on the oven or microwave if there is a fire.
- Clothing: Watch what you are wearing such as long sleeves.
- Types of Fire Extinguishers: A, combustibles such as paper or wood; B, gas, flammable liquids; E, electrical fires; D, flammable metals (magnesium); and K, heavy grease.
- Locations for extinguishers: under the sink and in garage

Remember: Pull, Aim, Squeeze and Sweep

The attendees divided up into groups and practiced using a fire extinguisher. It was a great hands-on experience.

Remember to change your batteries in your smoke alarms at this time of year.
