# Presentation by Freedom Roath from Adams County Outreach and Education

Freedom talked about the many programs that are available.

**SNAP:** Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program. It serves as part of a federal nutrition program to help low-income households purchase food. He also told about other food resources that are available.

<u>MA/MSP</u>: These are the Medicaid and Medicare programs. Health First Colorado covers 3 kinds of benefits: physical, dental and behavioral health. There are 4 tiers of Medicare Savings programs which covers premiums, deductibles, coinsurance, and copayments. Each of these programs has an income and resource limit.

<u>CW/TANF</u>: Colorado Works is Colorado's temporary assistance for needy families. It provides cash assistance which can be used for items a family needs such as food, clothes, formula, diapers, etc. There are specific eligibility requirements.

AF: Adult Financial Programs. This program provides financial assistance to low-income aged, blind and people with disabilities who need help in meeting basic living costs.

LEAP: Low-Income energy assistance is active between November through April.
