## Presentation by Amy Herrick CarePatrol

Amy Herrick, a Certified Senior Advisor with CarePatrol has managed assisted livings for 20 years and has been placing seniors in those facilities since 2015.

Colorado has 572 assisted living facilities and as of 2023 more than 818,800 Americans reside in assisted living communities. There are over 30,600 active assisted living facilities, operating at an average capacity of nearly 80 %.

Amy will discuss the age and gender demographics in assisted living as well as the pay for assisted living. What considerations do you consider when searching for assisted living? How long does it take to find and move into one? What is the difference between assisted living and skilled nursing and memory care?

### Guest Speaker: Michael Sisneros from Aftersight

<u>Aftersight</u> provides audio editions that take local print and convert it into audio by leveraging a team of volunteers. Audio Editions include local newspapers, state/regional magazines, grocery store ads, bus guides, disaster prep manuals and more. Programming is available in English and Spanish and free. <u>Audio Editions</u> believe that this accessibility is foundational for people working to remain autonomous or to age in place.

<u>Aftersight Originals</u> are podcasts that are for and by people with low vision or blindness. Three of the four are hosted by someone with vision loss. They fill needs gaps which have been identified by the people they serve and cover a huge array of topics.

**Navigating Life with Vision Loss** is a weekly program that talks about getting connected to benefits, guide dogs, how to use transit, self-defense, how to stand up for yourself and much more.

**<u>Blind Sight</u>** is hosted by a mental health professional who is blind.

<u>Blind Level Tech</u> is a program devoted to technology that can help make life with vision loss easier.

Michael shared the different items that they use to provide this service to the visually impaired.
