Presentation by Dr. Jessica Schuman Mile High Senior Eyecare

Mile High Senior Eyecare is a mobile optometry practice focused on providing high-quality on-site medical eye care and glasses. They specialize in residents in senior living communities, homebound people, those with mobility challenges and those with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Eye health assessments, ocular disease diagnosis and treatments as well as prescriptions are offered. Most insurances are excepted and costs are minimal. Eye care is important as studies show that vision loss is associated with a higher prevalence of chronic health conditions, death, falls and injuries, depression, and social isolation. Dr. Schuman talked about the different ways that patients see such as diabetic retinopathy, astigmatism, glaucoma, macular degeneration, cataract and hemianopsia. She also looks at managing high risk medicines. Her tests and exams include visual acuity testing, refractive evaluation, eye muscle and visual field testing, corneal exams, glaucoma testing and examination of the back of the eye, retina, and underlying blood vessels. There was much interest and many questions from the group.
