The goal is to provide a better quality of life, move better and have less pain. Their services help residents and the community make any needed gains toward greater independence.

Physical Therapy provides energy and ease of movement, walking, strengthening, flexibility, balance, pain management, prosthetic training, and brace fitting.

Occupational Therapy gives a person tools to make daily tasks easier by simplifying the day, home management, coordination, writing skills, and energy conservation.

Speech Therapy helps to improve memory, organizing thought, problem solving, finding the words you want to say, speaking clearly and swallowing. These therapies allow them to work on the **whole body** with the patient.
