Presentation by Nic Saucy -- Project Angel Heart

"Project Angel Heart" is the Rocky Mountain-region expert in food as medicine and providing medically tailored meals. Regardless of a person's background or circumstances, Project Angel Heart believes everyone should have access to the nutrition they need—especially when they are sick. This year, Angel Heart will prepare and deliver 755,000 medically tailored meals to 5,000 Coloradans living with cancer, end-stage renal disease, congestive heart failure, and other severe illnesses. Nic Soucy, Government Affairs Manager, will speak about the services Project Angel Heart offers, how to get involved with the program, and the importance of "Food is Medicine"."

10 Warning Signs of Alzheimer's:

Memory loss that disrupts daily life; Challenges in planning or solving problems; Difficulty completing familiar tasks; Confusion with time or place; Trouble understanding visual images and spatial relationships; New problems with words in speaking or writing; Misplacing things and losing the ability to retrace steps; Decreased or poor judgment; Withdrawal from work or social activities; and Changes in mood and personality.

Early Detection is important:

Access the situation- What changes do you see? What else is going on? Learn about the signs and benefits of early diagnosis. Has anyone else noticed the changes? Have a conversation. Who should have the conversation. What is the best time and place to have a conversation? What will you or the person say? Offer to go with the person to the doctor or doctors; vision and hearing may play a part. If needed, have multiple conversations. Reach out for support. Turn to the Alzheimer's Association for more help.
