Attendees introduced themselves and made announcements around the room. Liv Bergman gave a report on DRCOG.

AllWays Supportive Care (formally the Guide program) Presentation by Tessa Scott

Tessa talked about dementia and what we know about it today. It affects 2 or more parts of the brain, progresses over time and is qualified as a terminal illness. Alzheimer's dementia, vascular, lewy body and frontotemporal are some types of disease. Where the damage occurs in the brain determines such symptons as



language and communication skills, as well as speaking, and behaviors. There is no cure currently; however, lots of research is on the horizon.

The Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services was the birthplace for the Guide program, and it develops and tests healthcare payment and service delivery models. Its purpose is to improve the quality of life for those living with dementia and reduce strain on their unpaid caregivers. It is free to qualifying participants! To qualify, one needs an original Medicare plan and a dementia diagnosis. AllWays Supportive Care provides symptom management with connections to community resources, dementia specialized patient navigators, ongoing support through the illness progression, caregiver education and training, 24/7, access to an on-call social worker, advanced care planning, long term care planning and \$2500. towards in-home respite services. They partner with several organizations in the community as well.
